

Michelle Lynn Holsey Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

Purpose: The purpose of the Michelle Lynn Holsey Foundation College Scholarship Award is to assist students who are economically disadvantaged. One scholarship of up to \$750.00 in value may be awarded.

Eligibility Requirements: In order to be eligible for consideration, scholarship applicant must:

- Be economically disadvantaged.
- Be a prospective high school graduate in May.
- Must attend a state-supported college, university, community college or trade school in Texas.
- Be a U.S. citizen, and reside in Houston County. MLH Foundation board may choose to include surrounding areas of Houston County.

Nondiscrimination Statement: The Foundation is fair and equal in all its scholarship processes for all persons without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, or any other characteristic protected by law.

Application Submission Instruction: In order to be eligible for consideration scholarship application must:

- Provide a copy of parent's last tax return to the MLH Foundation.
- Application must be mailed to the MLH Foundation by March 15.
- Application must be typed or printed in blue or black ink, be clearly legible and submitted in English. Essay must be typewritten.
- Provide one letter of recommendation from a teacher, a high school counselor and or third person selected by applicant. Counselor must attach the applicant's academic transcript and test scores.
- Supply all requested information. If any information is incomplete, the application will be rejected.
- Include current and accurate contact information. The Michelle Lynn Holsey Foundation will contact you at the phone number or physical address provided.
- Provide all signatures when indicated on the application.
